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Caring for Your Glassware

Dishwasher Use

Many customers find a properly spaced low-temperature glass cycle helps preserve long-term clarity while reducing unnecessary handling.

- Use a low-temperature glass cycle (max 55°C)
- Ensure glasses are well spaced and secure before starting a cycle
- Avoid contact between glasses, metal racks, or heavy items during washing cycles
- Use quality non-aggressive detergents and suitable rinse aids where required
- Ensure correct water hardness settings to help preserve clarity over time
- Avoid frequent high-temperature cycles

Hand Washing

If washing by hand, clean gently using warm water, mild detergent, and minimal pressure during handling.

- Support the bowl lightly and avoid gripping, squeezing, or applying pressure during cleaning, particularly when wet
- Do not twist the stem or bowl while washing or drying
- Use a soft cloth or sponge only
- Avoid pressure inside the bowl when using cloths or sponges
- Dry promptly using a lint-free cloth to minimise water marking
- Avoid sudden temperature changes between hot and cold water



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Final Care And Handling

Drying & Finishing

- Allow the glass to cool before polishing
- Polish gently using a lint-free cloth
- Handle carefully when drying the bowl and stem
- Store separately to avoid contact between glasses

Handling

TW Prestige glassware is designed for balance, aroma, and experience. As with all fine stemware, careful handling helps preserve long-term clarity and structure.

- Avoid pressure on the rim or sides of the bowl
- Avoid gripping tightly when cleaning or drying
- Keep glasses separated during handling and storage
- Avoid contact with taps, hard surfaces, or other glassware during handling and cleaning
- Avoid sudden temperature changes
- Open packaging, protective inserts, and sealed transit materials carefully to avoid unnecessary pressure or accidental impact during unboxing

Storage

- Store in a clean, dry environment
- Avoid overcrowding cupboards or racks
- Keep away from abrasive surfaces and strong odours
- Ensure glasses are fully dry before storing

A Final Note

Fine stemware is designed to enhance aroma, balance, and texture through its shape, balance, and thinness. Fine stemware responds differently depending on handling, water conditions, storage environments, cleaning methods, and temperature variation over time. Appropriate handling, spacing, storage, and cleaning practices will help preserve long-term clarity and structure. As with all fine stemware, care methods and handling conditions may affect long-term appearance and durability.
